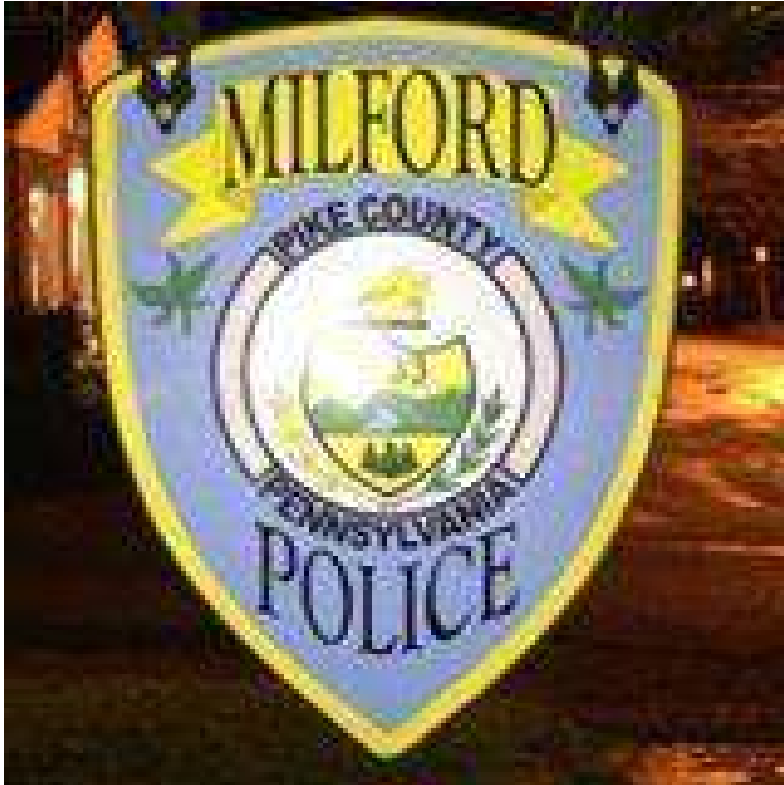

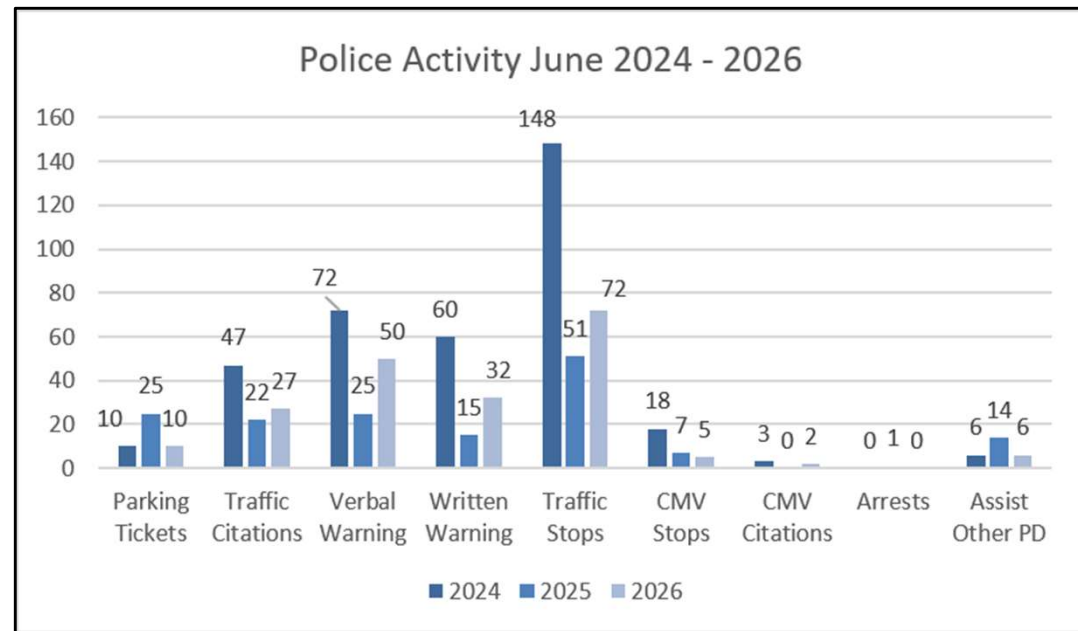
Mayor's Report: Milford Police Department – June 2026
