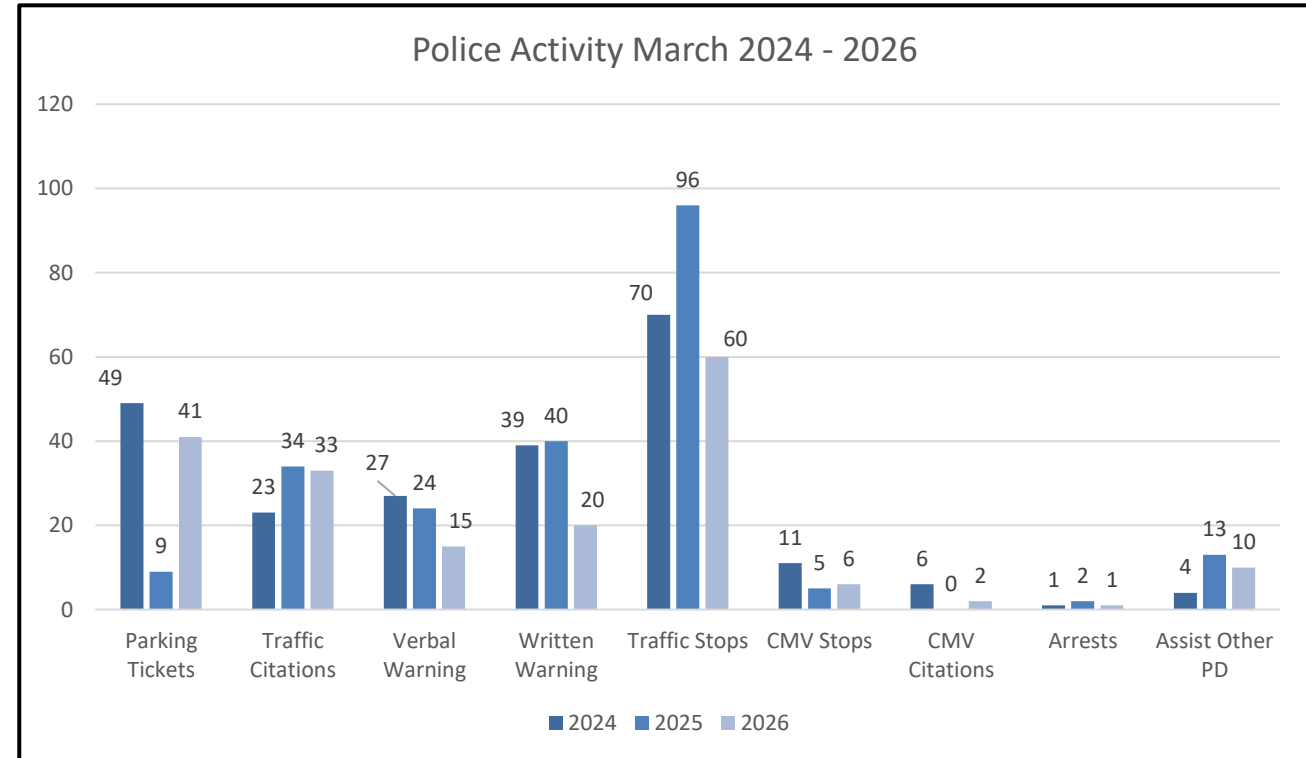
# Mayor's Report: Milford Police Department – March 2026
