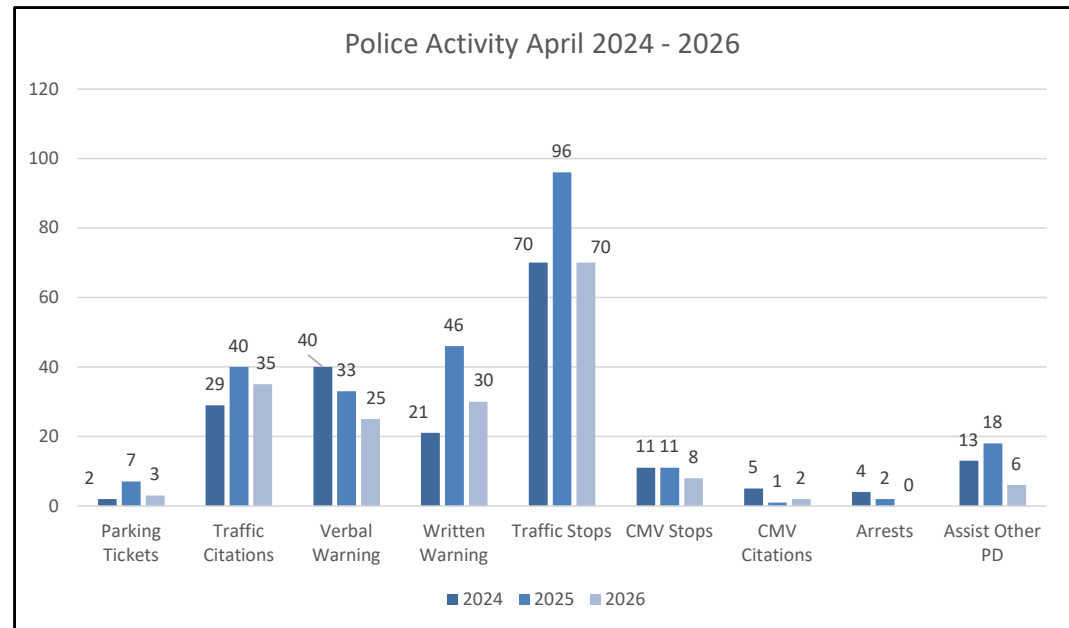
Mayor's Report: Milford Police Department – April 2026
