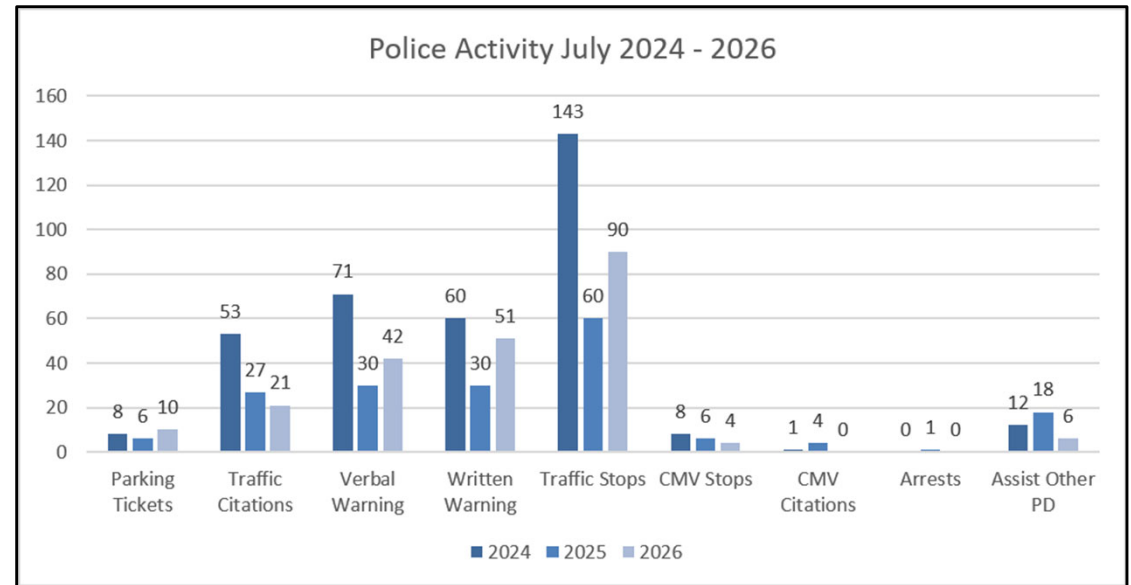
Mayor's Report: Milford Police Department – July 2026
