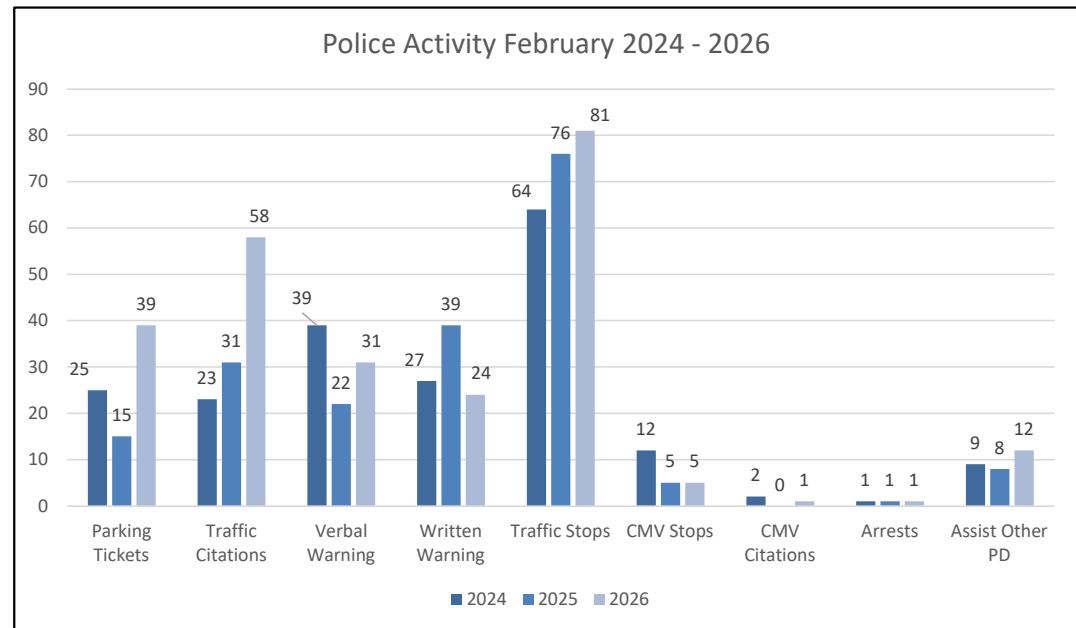
Mayor's Report: Milford Police Department – February 2026
