Chapter 260. Streets and Sidewalks

Article II. Openings and Excavations

§ 260-7. Permit required.

It shall be unlawful for any person to open or to make any excavation of any kind in any of the streets in the Borough of Milford without first securing a permit therefor as hereinafter provided.

§ 260-8. Application for permit.

Any person who shall desire to make any opening or excavation in any of the streets in the Borough of Milford shall make application to the Borough Secretary in writing for a permit therefor. Such application shall be made upon blanks to be furnished by the Borough and shall set forth the name of the applicant, the exact location of the proposed opening or excavation and the approximate size or depth thereof, and shall contain an agreement on the part of the applicant that the work shall be done in full compliance with the ordinances of the Borough and the laws of the commonwealth in relation thereto, and that the applicant shall well and truly save, defend and keep harmless the Borough from and indemnify it against any and all actions, suits, demands, payments, costs and charges arising from or by reason of the proposed opening or excavation and all damages to persons or property resulting in any manner therefrom or occurring in the prosecution of the work connected therewith, or from any other matter, cause or thing relating thereto.

§ 260-9. Permit fee; applicability.

- A. Permit fees. The Milford Borough Council shall, from time to time, designate such fees as they may deem appropriate by resolution. [Amended at time of adoption of Code (see Ch. 1, General Provisions, Art. I)]
- B. This article shall not apply to the Municipal Authority of the Borough of Milford.
